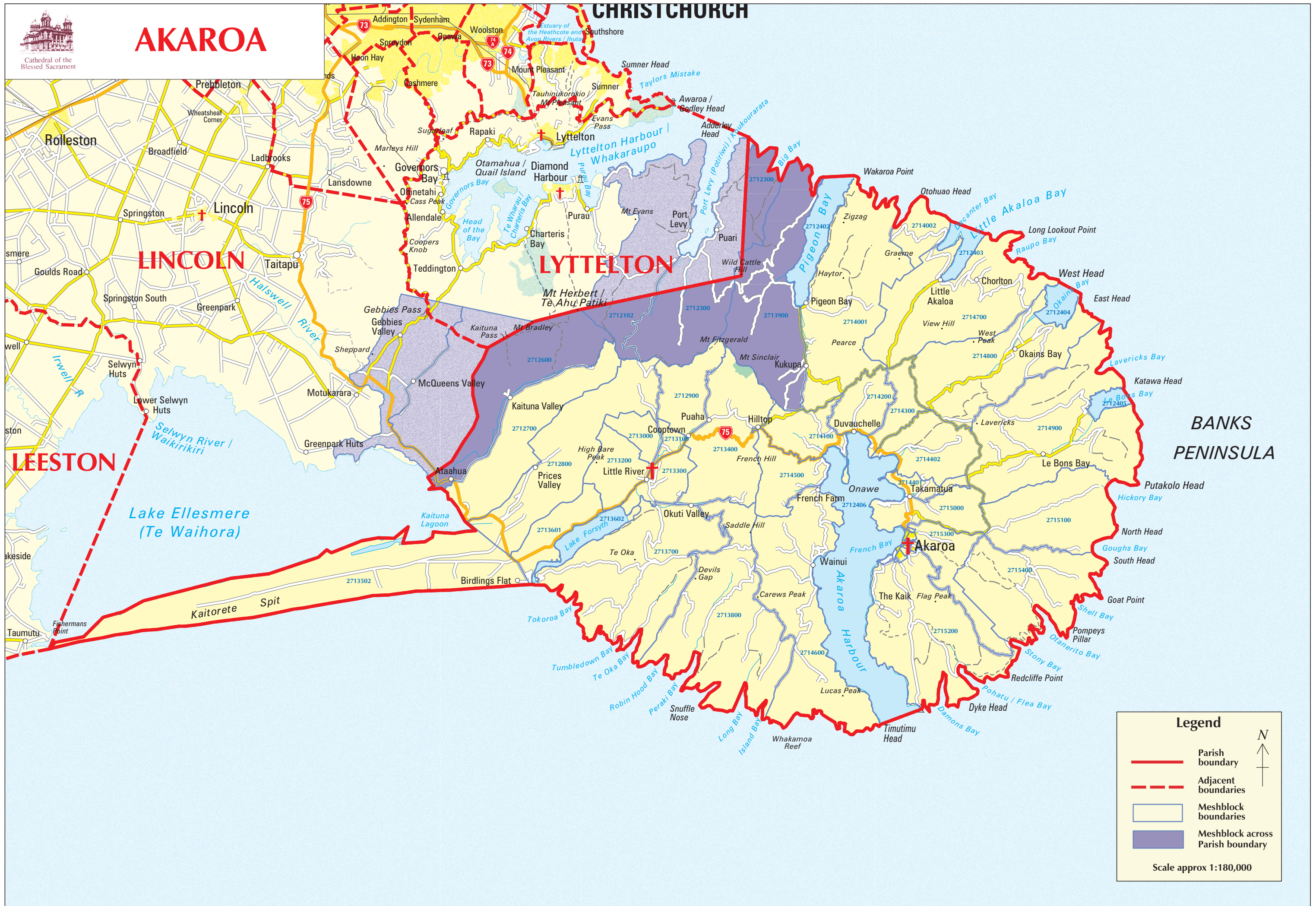


AKAROA



AKAROA PARISH

“St Patrick’s ”

Akaroa

“Commencing at the northern-most point of the Parish boundary being Baleine Point at the north-eastern entrance to Port Levy; bounded thence in a clockwise direction by the coast line of Banks Peninsula, to and across the entrances of Pigeon Bay and the Akaroa Harbour to the outlet of Lake Forsyth near Birdlings Flat; thence south-westerly by the coast line of the South Pacific Ocean to the outlet of Lake Ellesmere at Taumutu; thence returning north-easterly by the southern shore line of Lake Ellesmere to a point north-west of Kaituna in line with the main ridge of hills separating Kaituna Valley and McQueens Valley; thence north-easterly across the Main Akaroa Road to and by the summit of this main ridge of hills to the Summit Road of the Port Hills; thence by right lines respectively to Mt. Herbert, to Herbert Peak and to Wild Cattle Hill on the ridge between Pigeon Bay and Port Levy; thence northerly by a right line to the commencing point at Baleine Point.”
