Attendance Dues

Attendance Dues are a compulsory payment and are approved by the Minister of Education under the terms of the Education and Training Act 2020 and are a condition of enrolment at Villa Maria College. All students attending Catholic Schools in New Zealand are charged attendance dues.

Attendance dues are subject to change and are based on 2024 attendance dues of \$700 per student per year.

Student Care Fee

At Villa Maria College high-quality pastoral care and support is provided for all students which is covered by a student care fee. This will cover the cost of monitoring & continuous support for our students and the liaison with their homestay, agents, care providers and designated caregivers. Regardless of who students are living with, all students will be charged the student care fee.

Contingency Fee/Additional Costs

These are costs that students may incur once their subject is confirmed, and they are attending class. They vary according to the individual programme chosen by the student and are not covered by the standard tuition fee.

Addition costs also include extracurricular EOTC activities. This fee applies to all students.
